key vocabulary:

historic building – any building or structure that is significant in the history, architecture or culture of a community

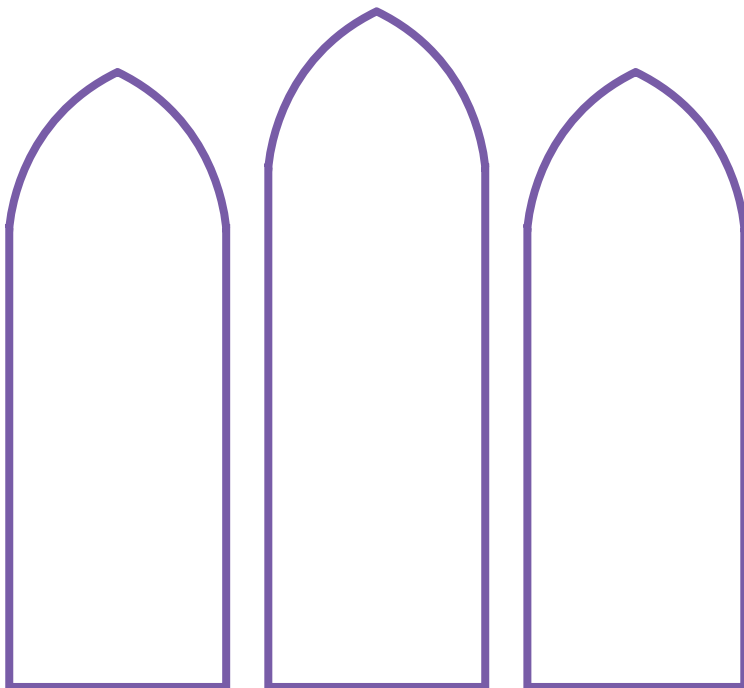
organ – a large musical instrument with rows of pipes that make sound with compressed air. It is played using one or more keyboards to produce a wide range of musical effects.

stained glass – colored glass used to form decorative designs or pictures, both by painting and especially by setting contrasting pieces in a lead framework like a mosaic.

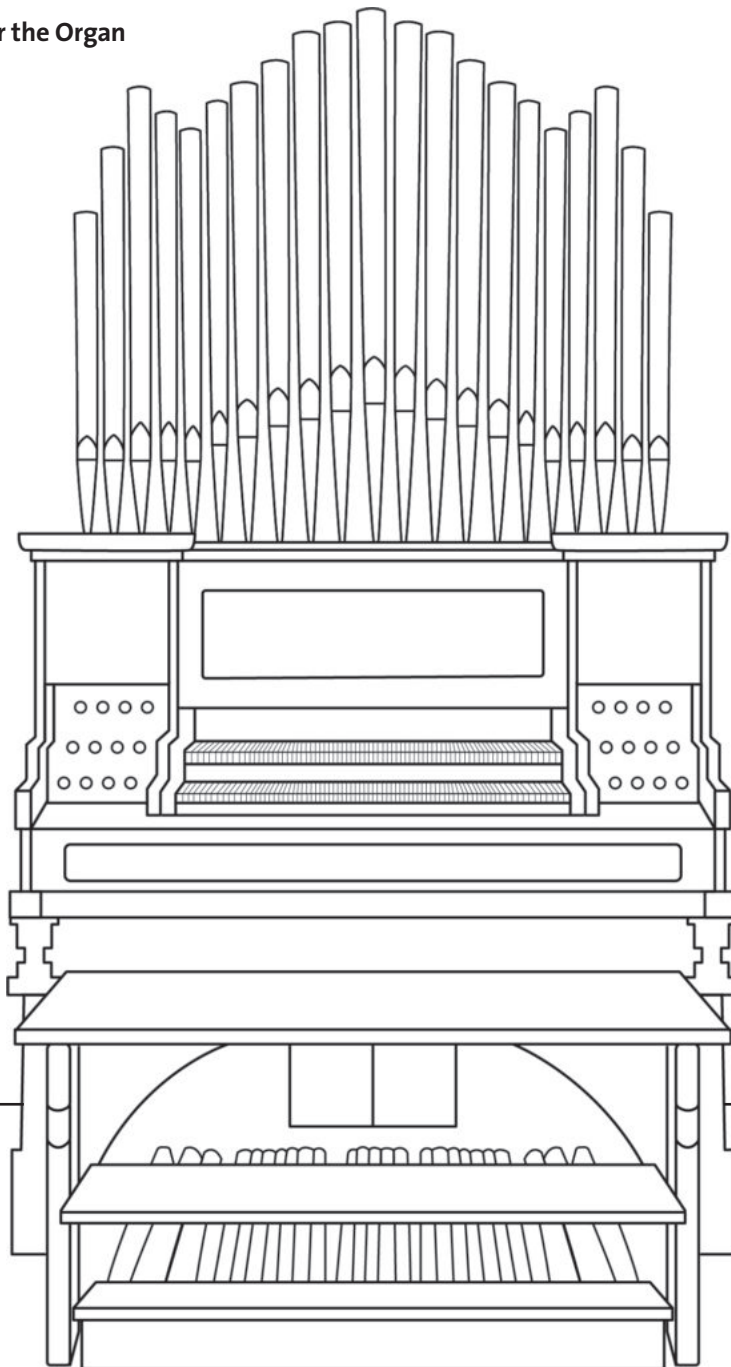
