4th Annual Cathedral Arts Project Golf Tournament raises more than \$113,000 for arts education in Northeast Florida

On Monday, October 5, the Cathedral Arts Project held the 4th Annual CAP Golf Tournament at Deerwood Country Club. The event, chaired by CAP board member Alan Fickling, exceeded its goal and raised \$113,630 in support of arts education for children in Northeast Florida. It is the only golf tournament to support arts education along the First Coast.

The rain let up just in time as 27 teams took to the course. Coastal Construction Products took home the grand prize with the best net score of the day, followed by Cecil W. Powell & Company in second place and Thigpen Heating and Air in third.

Golfers, staff and volunteers wore masks throughout the day and practiced social distancing at an outdoor awards ceremony, with Tournament Chair Alan Fickling and CAP Director of Development Sarah Hande speaking about the impact of the arts on the children served by CAP's programs.
